Developing Effective Specialized Responses

How to implement a case management approach that incorporates a specialized response for individuals with a developmental disability who also have behaviour issues and/or a dual diagnosis.

Who should attend:

Those who work as a case manager or who provide a case management function, service coordinator, community support worker, community facilitator, are **supporting some adults** who have a developmental disability and/or dual diagnosis and are interested in increasing their skills and knowledge in supporting this population.

The outcomes for **ESR** are:

- Identify commonalities and differences between sectors, at the individual, family, and system levels.
- Recognize the potential for dual diagnosis in a variety of settings.
- Conduct a bio-psycho-social assessment at the individual and family levels.
- Plan effectively with the individual and their family.
- Recognize systemic advocacy and how one can impact the system.
- Recognize the value of networking, collaboration, and a multidisciplinary approach.
